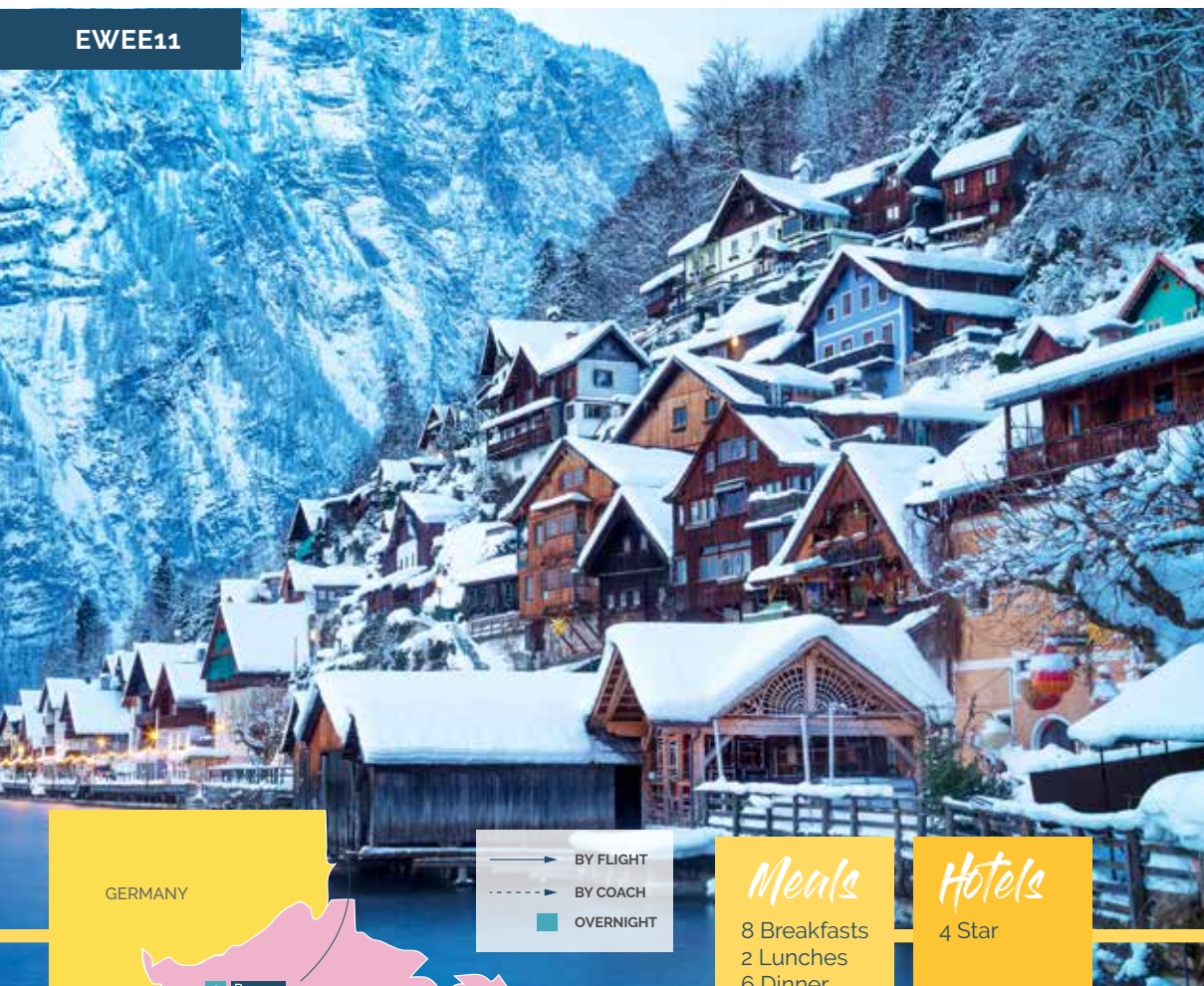

Dinner

- Mirabell Garden – Photo stop before proceeding to No. 9 Getreidegasse, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart House.
- Salzburg Old Town – Free at leisure for you to explore this place filled with baroque buildings.

Breakfast

- Schönbrunn Palace - Visit the former imperial summer residence (*entrance included*).
- Panoramic tour – Visit the State Opera, Rathaus and St. Stephen's Cathedral.



Day 05

- Excursion to Parndorf Designer Outlet – Spend some time shopping for luxury brands at discounted price before transferring to Budapest.
- Budapest – Have a traditional Hungarian Goulash dinner with Folkshow.



Day 06 Budapest

Breakfast | Lunch

- Budapest – With the city straddles the Danube in the magnificent natural setting where the hills of western Hungary meet the plains stretching to the east and south. Enjoy a panoramic tour of Budapest's landmark Chain Bridge, Matthias Church, Fisherman's Bastion, Gellért Hill and Heroes' Square.
- Excursion to Danube River Cruise – Embark on a cruise with drink.

Day 07 Budapest - Bratislava - Brno

Breakfast | Dinner

- Bratislava - Enjoy a walking tour through the old town and visit highlights places like Cumil, Napoleon Army Soldier Statue, Old Town Hall, Primatial Palace, St. Martin's Cathedral and Franciscan Square.

Day 08 Brno - Prague

- Prague – Go on a walking tour in the City of a Hundred Spires (UNESCO World Heritage Site) and visit the Prague Castle, St. Vitus Cathedral, Hradcany Castle and walk across the famous Charles Bridge and into old town and view the iconic Astronomical Clock.

Day 09 Prague - Cesky Krumlov - Prague

Breakfast | Dinner

- Excursion to Cesky Krumlov – This southwestern castle city is one of the finest medieval sites. Visit the Old Town (UNESCO World Heritage Site). Stroll through crooked cobblestone streets on foot and soak up the atmosphere of this impeccably preserved medieval gem above the Vltava River, an old town square with Renaissance and baroque architecture.

Breakfast | Meals on Board

- Prague – Free at leisure till transfer to the Prague airport for flight back home.
