

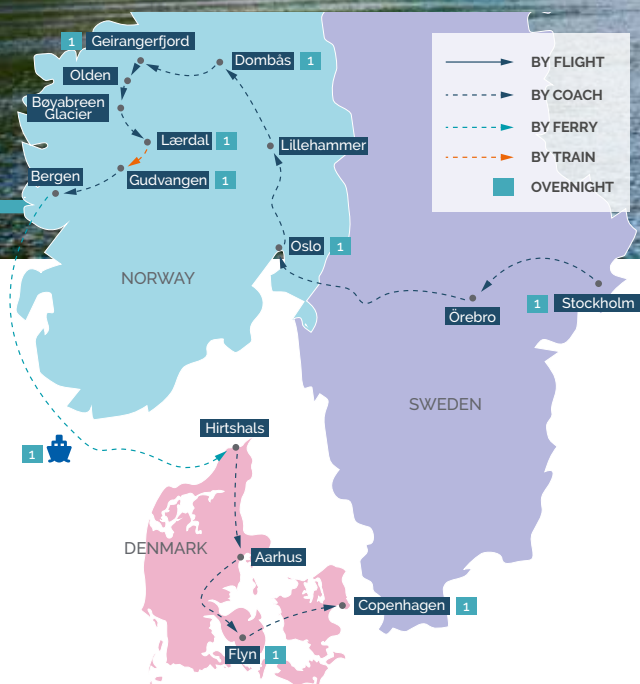

#### Day 01

### Departure - Stockholm

#### *Meals on Board*

- Assemble at Changi Airport for your long-haul flight to Stockholm, Sweden.

#### Day 02

### Stockholm

#### *Dinner*

- City Hall – Visit the Cathedral and Royal Palace.
- Drottningholm Palace – Sweden's best preserved royal palace constructed in the seventeenth century which is also the permanent resident of the royal family and one of Stockholm's three World Heritage Sites.



#### Day 03

### Stockholm - Örebro Castle - Oslo

#### *Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner*

- Örebro Castle – Photo stop at the castle that is surrounded by the river.
- Transfer to Oslo via Karlstad.
- Oslo City Tour – Visit the City Hall, Royal Palace and Oslo University with a photo stop at Vigeland Sculpture Park.

#### Day 04

### Oslo - Lillehammer - Dombås

#### *Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner*

- Lillehammer – Enjoy the breathtaking view along the way.
- Lyngårdsbakkene – Photo stop at the Ski Jumping Arena.



#### Day 05

### Dombås - Eagle Road - Geirangerfjord - Olden

#### *Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner*

- Eagle Road – Known for its name because at its highest point, it passed through terrain that had traditionally been the domain of a large number of eagles.

#### Day 06

### Olden - Bøyabreen Glacier - Aurland Tunnel - Laerdal

*Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner*

- Boyabreen Glacier – Experience having lunch at a special dedicated restaurant overlooking the Boyabreen Glacier.
- Sognefjord – Travel through the world's longest road tunnel for a photo stop.
- Stave Church – Finish the day with a photo stop at Stave Church which was built sometime between 1180 and 1250 AD.

#### Day 07

### Lærdal - Flam Railway - Nærøyfjord - Hardangerfjord - Gudvangen

*Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner*

- Excursion onboard the Flam Railway – Enjoy 2-hour cruise of the Nærøyfjord, Norway's longest and deepest fjord (UNESCO World Heritage Site). Travel to Nærøyfjord before having an overnight at Gudvangen.

#### Day 08

### Gudvangen - Bergen - Overnight Cruise

*Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner*

- Bergen City Tour – Have a walk-through medieval quarter of Bryggen and the open-air fish market. Take the Floibanen Funicular to get the best feel of the city.
- Ferry – In the late afternoon, embark onboard the ferry from Bergen to Hirtshals (*inside cabin included*).

#### Day 09

### Hirtshals - Aarhus - Flyn

*Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner*

- Hirtshals – Continue to Århus, the second largest city in Denmark.
- Århus – Embark on the city tour to Marselisbord Palace and Memorial Park

#### Day 10

### Flyn - Copenhagen

*Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner*

- Sightseeing – Tivoli Garden, City Square Hall, Hans Christian Andersen's Statue and Christiansborg Castle.
- Little Mermaid and Gefion Fountain – Photo stop opportunity and if time permits, we will stop by Nyhavn, a waterfront, canal and entertainment district.

- Copenhagen – Free at leisure till transport to the Copenhagen airport for flight back home.

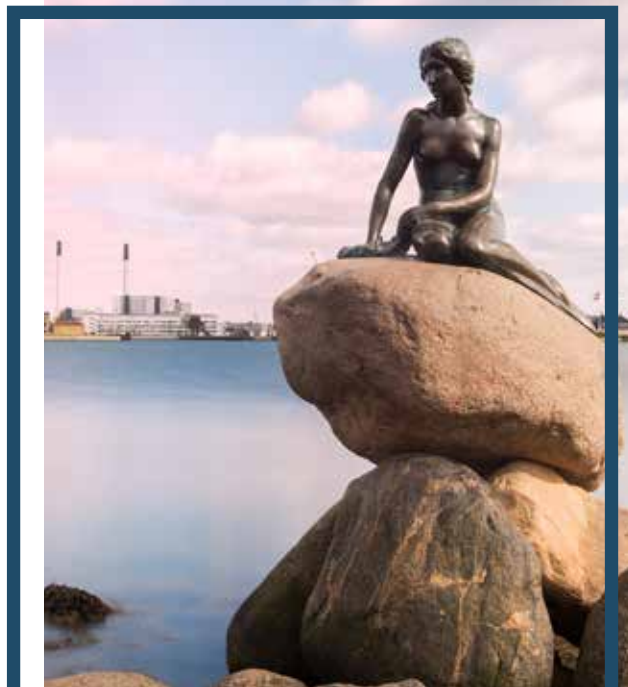

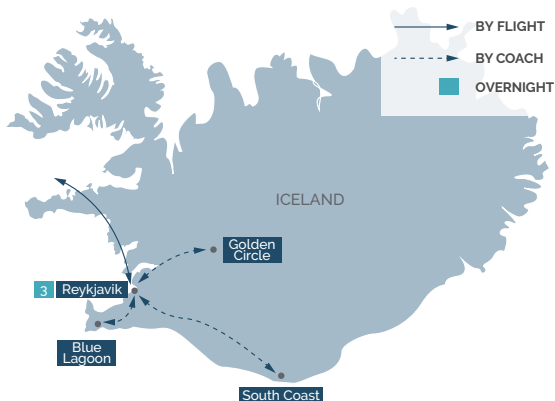

- Excursion to South Coast of Iceland – Visit the gorgeous waterfalls at Skógafoss and Seljalandfoss, admire the black beach and basalt cliffs at Reynisfjara and behold the breath-taking Sólheimajökull glacier.

### Day 13

#### Reykjavik - Golden Circle - Reykjavik

- Golden Circle – Visit the popular tourist route in South Iceland.
- Þingvellir (Thingvellir) National Park (UNESCO World Heritage Site) – Proceed on to Haukadalur geothermal area, the location of Geysir and its more active neighbor, Strokkur, which sprouts water every few minutes and to the majestic Gullfoss waterfall and the old implosion crater of Kerið.
