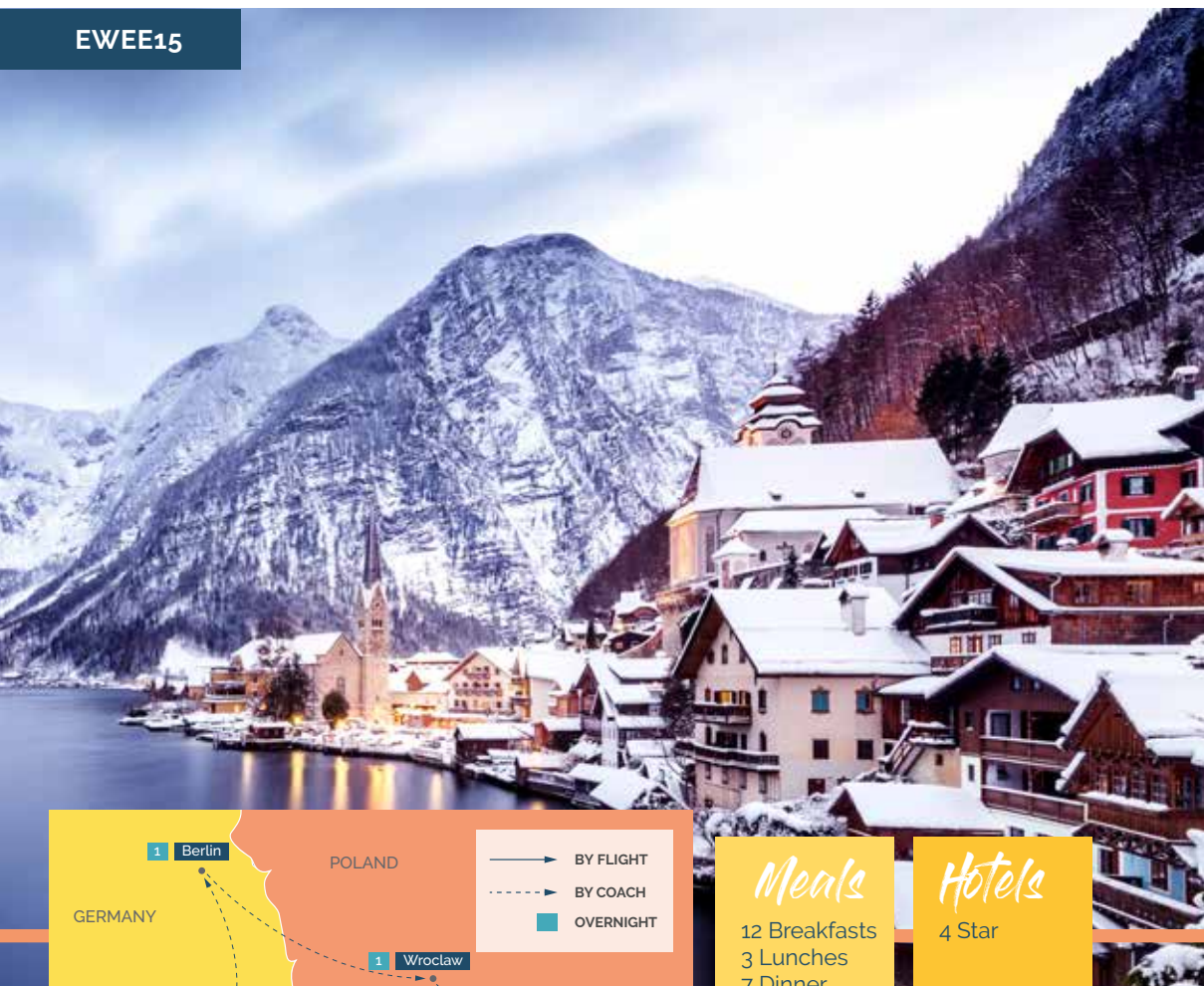

Day 01

Departure - Munich

Meals on Board

- Assemble at the Airport for your long-haul flight to Munich, Germany.

Day 02

Munich - Neuschwanstein - Schwangau

Dinner

- Schwangau – Visit Neuschwanstein Castle (*entrance included*) a 19th century Romanesque Revival Castle which is the inspiration for Disneyland's Sleeping Beauty Castle!

Day 03

Schwangau - Hallstatt - Salzburg

Breakfast | Dinner

- Hallstatt – Make a photo stop at one of the prettiest medieval towns, perched on the shores of a lake and surrounded by mountains.
- Salzburg – Birthplace of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart and is dominated by churches, castles and palaces. Visit its picturesque old town (UNESCO World Heritage Site).
- Mirabell Garden – Photo stop before proceeding to No. 9 Getreidegasse, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart House.
- Salzburg Old Town – Free at leisure for you to explore this place filled with baroque buildings.



Day 04

Salzburg - Cesky Krumlov - Ceske Budejovice

Breakfast | Dinner

- Excursion to Cesky Krumlov – This southwestern castle city is one of the finest medieval sites, visit its Old Town (UNESCO World Heritage Site). Stroll through crooked cobblestone streets on foot and soak up the atmosphere of this impeccably preserved medieval gem above the Vltava River, an old town square with Renaissance and baroque architecture.



Day 05

Ceske Budejovice - Prague

Breakfast | Dinner

- Prague – Go on a walking tour in the City of a Hundred Spires (UNESCO World Heritage Site) and visit the Prague Castle, St. Vitus Cathedral, Hradcany Castle and walk across the famous Charles Bridge and into old town and view the iconic Astronomical Clock.

Day 06

Prague - Dresden - Berlin

Breakfast | Dinner

- Dresden – Despite being destroyed in the World War II, the Altstadt (Old Town) has kept or regained its attractive buildings. Embark on a walking tour to well-known symbol of the rebuilding of the city centre, Frauenkirche (Church of Our Lady), the magnificent domed baroque church which again dominates the Dresden skyline.
- Photo stop at Zwinger Palace, Semper Opera House and the Fürstenzug.

Day 07

Berlin - Wrocław

Breakfast | Lunch

- Berlin – Take a tour around the city and enjoy the city's main cultural and historical sights, Berlin Wall, Museum Island, Reichstag, Alexanderplatz, Checkpoint Charlie, Unter den Linden and the Jewish Museum. Photo stop opportunity at Berlin's icon, Brandenburg Gate.
- Wrocław – Having absorbed the Bohemian, Austrian and Prussian influences, explore the city's unique architectural and cultural make-up, symbolized by its magnificent Market Square and Town Hall.

Day 08

Wrocław - Auschwitz Camp - Krakow

Breakfast | Lunch

- Oświęcim – Visit Auschwitz Concentration Camp (*entrance included*), operated in areas of Poland that were annexed by Nazi Germany during World War II.

Day 09

Krakow - Wieliczka Salt Mine - Krakow

Breakfast | Lunch

- Krakow – Take a walking tour through Poland's prettiest main city and visit Wawel Castle, Market Square, Cloth Hall, St Mary Basilica
- Excursion to Wieliczka (UNESCO World Heritage Site) – Visit Wieliczka Salt Mine (*entrance included*) to learn about the most valuable monuments of material and spiritual culture in Poland

Day 10

Krakow - Donovaly - Budapest

Breakfast | Dinner

- Long distance transfer from Krakow to Budapest via Donovaly

Day 11

Budapest

Breakfast | Dinner

- Budapest – With the city straddles the Danube in the magnificent natural setting where the hills of western Hungary meet the plains stretching to the east and south. Enjoy a panoramic tour of Budapest's landmark Chain Bridge, Matthias Church, Fisherman's Bastion, Gellért Hill and Heroes' Square.
- Excursion to Danube River Cruise – Embark on a cruise with drink.

Day 12

Budapest - Parndorf Designer Outlet - Vienna

- Excursion to Parndorf Designer Outlet – Spend some time shopping for luxury brands at discounted price before transferring to Vienna.

Vienna

Breakfast

- Vienna – The Vienna's imperial grandeur is the legacy of the powerful Habsburg monarchy for more than 6 centuries.
- Schönbrunn Palace - Visit the former imperial summer residence (*entrance included*).
- Panoramic tour – Photo stop at State Opera, Rathaus and St. Stephen's Cathedral.
