##### Lunch

- **Vatican** (UNESCO World Heritage Site) – Visit **St Peter's Basilica** in the Vatican City, the world's largest cathedral where you will find one of Michelangelo's finest works, "Pietà".
- **Colosseum** (UNESCO World Heritage Site) – Photo stop outside the Grand Amphitheatre.
- **Trevi Fountain** – Toss a coin over your left shoulder into the fountain and make a wish!
- **The Spanish Steps** - Set of steps named after the Spanish Embassy, climbing a steep slope between the Piazza di Spagna at the base and Piazza Trinità dei Monti, dominated by the Trinità dei Monti church at the top.

#### Rome - Siena - Prato

##### Buffet Breakfast | Lunch

- **Excursion to Siena** (UNESCO World Heritage Site) – With a very long history, dating back to Etruscan era. The main development of the city happened through the Middle-Ages. Piazza del Campo in the heart of Siena, it's considered one of Europe's greatest medieval squares. You can enjoy the town by having a cup of coffee at one of the several bars.
- En-route, visit a local Italian product shop.

- **Florence** (UNESCO World Heritage Site) – Train ride to Santa Novella Station and embark on a walking tour to the Historic Center of Florence. View the exterior façade of the Santa Maria del Fiore Duomo Cathedral, Ponte Vecchio and the "Piggy Market".
- **Piazza Signoria** – World famous square with plenty of Renaissance sculptures.

### Prato - Le Spezia - Pisa - Prato

- **Excursion to Cinque Terre** (UNESCO World Heritage Site) – Embark on a train ride from La Spezia to Manarola, Vernazza and Riomaggiore.
- **Pisa - Piazza dei Miracoli** (UNESCO World Heritage Site) – At the Square of Miracles, view the famous trio: The leaning Tower of Pisa, the Baptistery and the Duomo.

### Prato - Venice

- **St. Mark's Square** – Board a water taxi to San Marco and catch sights of St. Mark's Basilica, Doge's Palace and the celebrated Bridge of Sighs.
- **Glass Blowing Factory** – Experience how richly coloured Venetian glass is made to world class standard.

### Venice - Noventa di Piave Designer Outlet - Sirmione - Milan

- **Noventa di Piave Designer Outlet** – A wide variety of products and items at huge discounts!
- **Sirmione** – Admire the beautiful old town and the Scaliger Castle. Enjoy the spectacular sight of Lake Garda.

- **Da Vinci Square** – View the statue of Leonardo da Vinci and also the famous opera theatre, Teatro alla Scala.
