#### Departure - Athens

- Assemble at the airport for your long-haul flight to **Athens, Greece**.

#### Day 02

#### Athens

##### *Dinner*

- Arrive at Athens and depart for sightseeing tour at Acropolis site and museum.

#### Day 03

#### Athens - Zakynthos

##### *Buffet Breakfast | Dinner*

- After Buffet Breakfast, depart for Killini port to embark on the ferry for Zakynthos Island.
- **Blue Caves** – Set in the cliffs below Cape Skinari are the Blue Caves, the striking rock formations where the water reflects more shades of blue than an artist' palette. You can't go inside, but the boat will make a brief stop nearby so that you can capture the colours on camera.
- **Shipwreck Cove** – the beautiful bay which is only accessible by sea. You'll have around an hour here to cool off in the super – clear water, swim to the beach and see the half-buried shipwreck or just stay on deck and lap up the sunrays before the boat returns to Skinari.

*\* In the event of unforeseen weather, boat tour will be replaced by factory outlet in Athens.*

#### Day 04

### Zakynthos - Ioannina - Metsovo - Kalambaka

*Buffet Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner*

- **Ioannina** – Start your walking tour to explore, Ioannina's historic center, touched by a plethora of cultures, it is strong with Christian, Muslim and Jewish influences. Narrow streets are plenty of coffee shops and gift shops. Ioannina is also known as the city of silversmiths and as gastronomical paradise.
- **Metsovo** – A stunning little alpine village offering you its natural surrounding beauties. Start to stroll around its streets where lots of pretty shops selling woodcraft and local smoked cheeses. See the art and culture introducing you to an ongoing tradition. Walk through this gray stone village with red tile roofs and its green surrounding. Admire the two storey mansions, with their traditionally constructed balconies and wooden doors. Depart via picturesque villages to **Kalambaka**.



#### Day 05

### Kalambaka - Meteora - Athens

*Buffet Breakfast*

- **Meteora** – Visit two of the breathtaking monasteries of Meteora where you can see exquisite specimens of Byzantine art. Perched on huge granite rocks, the monasteries seem to suspend between earth and sky, providing a magnificent view. Each monastery contains priceless historical and religious treasures.
- **Leonidas Monument** – Trikala, Lamia and Thermopylae where a stop will be made to visit the memorial of Leonidas and the brave 300 Spartans.



#### Day 06

### Athens - Santorini

*Buffet Breakfast*

- Transfer to airport for your domestic flight to Santorini.
- **Fira town** – Start your walking tour at the capital of the island.
- Free at leisure.

**Santorini**

*Buffet Breakfast*

- **Excursion to Oia** – Drive to Kamari, the famous black beach, which unique color was created by the eruption of the volcano in the ancient times. Continue your tour to Pyrgos, a village found at the highest point of Santorini, with panoramic views of the whole island all the way to the village of Oia, which will be your final point of destination. The village of Oia is the most photographed place in Greece, best known for its breathtaking sunsets.

**Day 08**  
**Santorini - Mykonos**

*Buffet Breakfast*

- **Mykonos** – Discover the cosmopolitan town with its whitewashed cubic houses, windmills and chapels. Explore the towns' beautiful narrow streets with traditional shops and restaurants, little Venice with the famous windmills and a number of small chapels around nearly every corner.
- Free at leisure.

**Day 09**  
**Mykonos - Delos - Mykonos**

*Buffet Breakfast*

- Embark to one of the local ferries to Delos.
- **Excursion to Delos** – An islet of the Aegean, nowadays uninhabited, one of the most important archaeological sites in the eastern Mediterranean Sea. Delos is the legendary birthplace of the twin gods, Apollo and Artemis. Remains of temples and residences on Delos are dating back from the Neolithic to the Roman periods. The tour includes amongst others, a visit of the remains of the Temple of Apollo, the Sanctuary of Artemis, the Old city and the Theater and a walk down the celebrated Lion Street. Also, in the Museum of Delos, admire Archaic, Classical, Hellenistic and Roman sculptures, a collection of vessels from all periods as well as items of everyday use.

**Mykonos - Athens**

*Buffet Breakfast*

- Transfer to port for your domestic ferry to Athens.
- Free at leisure.

**Day 11**  
**Athens - Home**

*Buffet Breakfast*

- Free at leisure till transfer to the airport for flight back home.
